

**Turkish: Odden p. 211-213**

For the vowel harmony, first do morphological analysis and list the various forms of the suffixes, for example:

Possessive suffix: [i, ü, u, ı] what do these have in common? make that their underlying form Repeat with the other suffixes, and then figure out the rule(s).

Assume the vowel inventory is:

i	ü	ı	u
e	ö	o

and the features are:

round	-	-	+	+	-	-	+	+

**Some other rules to look for, affecting noun stems:**

vowel lengthening or vowel shortening?

consonant doubling or consonant deletion?

these two you can relate to syllable structure

intervocalic voicing or some kind of devoicing?
